Pain, Pain, Go Away: Helping Children With Pain

The best way to measure pain is to ask the child how much he or she hurts Only the child with pain knows how bad the pain is Children should be asked about pain in ways they understand and encouraged to tell how much pain they have Children under 4 years of age can often tell us that they are hurting However, they usually cannot say

Pain & Symptom Management

- Your pain scale rating with 0 being no pain and 10 being the worst imaginable pain
- What the pain feels like (stabbing, squeezing, aching, burning, tingling, throbbing, etc)
- What you do to lessen the pain and what makes it worse
- How pain affects your daily life (sleep, appetite, activities, emotions)

2019 HEDIS Measures

pain that did not have an imaging study (plain X-ray, MRI, CT scan) within 28 days of the diagnosis The measurement period is January 1st - December 3rd of the measurement year as imaging studies are captured 28 days after diagnosis of low back pain *** The measure is reported as an inverted rate A higher score indicates appropriate
