Tips For Infant & Toddler Teachers and Caregivers A language-rich environment is one in which babies and toddlers are surrounded by talking, singing, and reading and have many opportunities throughout their day, across all activities, to communicate with others and engage in back-and-forth interactions

encourage your baby to be active from day one Toddlers With lots of fun play from morning to bedtime, encourage your child to be active for at least 180 minutes (3 hours) every day Under fives Your child should stay on the move and avoid sitting still for too long Limit the time your child spends in a buggy, car seat or high-chair

Rules 407 Licensing Standards for Day Care Centers

a) The purpose of this Part is to prescribe the minimum standards for licensure as a day care center and to describe how to apply for a license This Part also establishes requirements for the daily operation of day care centers that serve children The Child Care Act of 1969 excludes some facilities from the requirement to be licensed
