1934 allowed the Germans to build battleships with a standard displacement of 35,000 long tons; various "escalator" clauses had, with complete legality, increased this limit to 45,000

Yamato on her trials, October 1941, off Bungo Strait The WWII Japanese battleships Yamato and Masashi were each 72,000 tons—twice the size of the biggest US (Iowa Class) battleships (35,000 tons) They fired a shell (181" [460 mm] in diameter, 3200 pounds)—50% heavier than anything the US had
